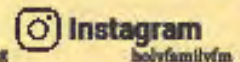
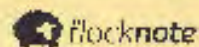

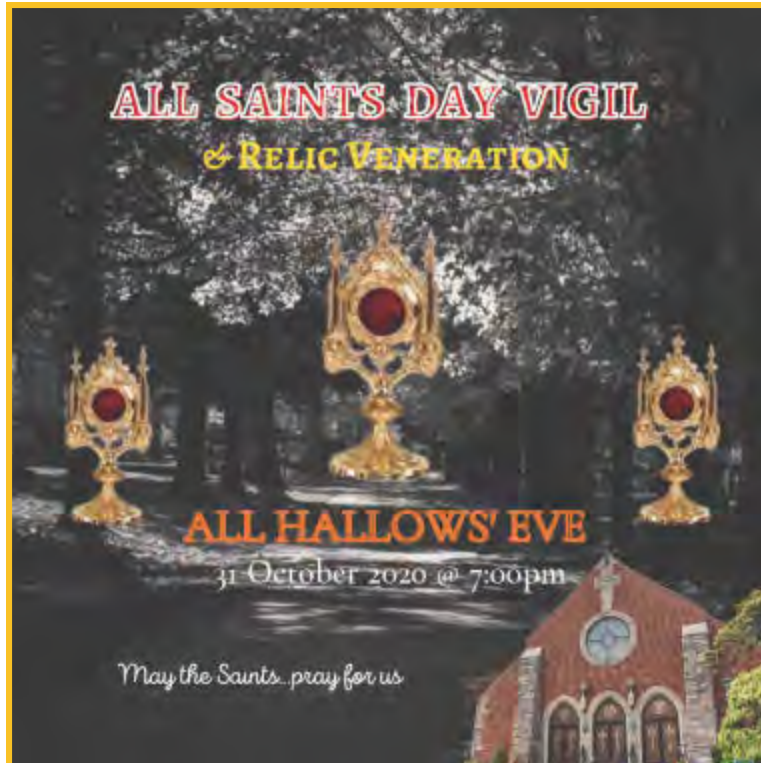
All Saints Procession : November 1, 2020
