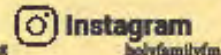
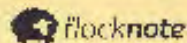

Dear Parishioners,

I am happy to announce the return of the Parish Bulletin! Please take the Bulletin home with you and do not leave it in the pews after Mass for sanitary reasons. I appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

This weekend, as a parish family we celebrate with Msgr. Furnari, the conferral of Papal Honors bestowed upon him by Pope Francis.

The title of “Monsignor” is bestowed on a priest who has distinguished himself by exceptional service to the church. It is a title granted only by the Holy Father — typically, upon the recommendation of the diocesan bishop. It is a purely honorary title and has no effect on the priest’s duties or ministerial assignment. In January 2014, Pope Francis had instructed the bishops of the world that diocesan priests would no longer be awarded the title before reaching the age of 65. No reasons were published for the pope’s decision, but Pope Francis has often cautioned priests against careerism and personal ambition.

In 1968, Pope Paul VI in his motu proprio *Pontificalis Domus*, the Holy Father reduced all the different grades of Monsignors into three different classes or ranks. Currently, the three classes (ranks) of Monsignors are:

Protonotary Apostolic – is the highest grade of Monsignor. These Monsignors are permitted to wear the manteletta with a black biretta with a red tuft. Commonly, this rank of Monsignor’s put the letters P.A. at the end of their name as well.

Honorary Prelates- is the second grade of Monsignor. They are permitted two different types of cassocks. The first cassock (house cassock) is a Red-trimmed black cassock with purple sash for all occasions. The red is the same shade as that used by bishops. The second cassock is a magenta cassock as their choir dress for liturgical events of special solemnity.

Chaplains of His Holiness- is the third grade of Monsignor. These Monsignors use a magenta-trimmed black [cassock](#) with a magenta [sash](#) for all occasions.

Our Holy Father, very graciously honored the request of Bishop DiMarzio in the name of the Diocese of Brooklyn to honor nine priests with the title of Monsignor which identifies them with the Vicar of Christ as Chaplains of His Holiness. This honor comes with the acknowledgement of their priestly zeal and service.

Msgr. Furnari served as an assistant priest at St. Rosalia-Regina Pacis, Brooklyn, 1968-80; Mary’s Nativity, Flushing, 1980-94; St. Jude, Canarsie, 1994-96; and Our Lady of the Snows, North Floral Park, 1996-98. In 1998, he was appointed pastor of Queen of All Saints, Fort Greene, Brooklyn; and in 2003, as pastor of St. Mary, Mother of Jesus, Bensonhurst. In 2009, he was named administrator to Bishop Ignatius A. Catanello and became our pastor in 2013-2019. We are very blessed & happy that he continues to share his priesthood and ministry with us in his retirement.
