With the title of Monsignor bestowed upon Fr. Furnari, Pope Francis recognizes his priestly ministry in service to the Diocese of Brooklyn. As a parish family, we will celebrate with Msgr. Furnari with Holy Mass.

Because of New York State's regulations during Covid-19 we are only allowed 25% capacity. Since the capacity has been reached for the October 4th 3:00 PM Mass we are unable to seat any more at this Mass.

However, Msgr. Furnari will be celebrating the 10:30 am Mass that day as well. Seating is limited and we will also be live-streaming both Masses on this website.

Families from the same household (or those who have been quarantined together) may sit together as a group.
